- A free analysis of your leadership and management skills, highlighting your strengths and areas for development
 - A training grant of £500 to help you address those areas
 - A further £500 grant for training for yourself and/or your senior team provided you match £ for £
- E.g. spend £850 on a development activity and you will only pay £175

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Your individual analysis can be carried out on-line or face-to-face. A Leadership and Management Specialist Adviser will then talk you through the results and use their expertise to suggest approaches and solutions designed to suit your learning style, time restraints and location.

Training does not need to be qualification based, and can include 1:1 coaching or mentoring, any continuous professional development you consider vital to business success. Training should be for your development or for someone in your business who has 'strategic responsibility' as well. NB: we cannot support sector-specific training or mandatory programmes.
